#### **Third-Party Approvals and Accreditations**

Most houses on this list have pursued third-party approvals and/or accreditations to varying degrees from local agencies or state entities. This specifically refers to three entities and processes:

- Accreditation from the Tennessee Alliance of Recovery Residences (TNARR), our state affiliate for the National Alliance
  of Recovery Residences (NARR).
- Approval from the Tennessee Department of Correction (TDOC), which is subject to change on a monthly basis.
- Approval from Metro Drug Coalition (MDC) through participation in their Recovery Housing Support Fund.

Houses with TNARR accreditation, TDOC approval, and/or MDC approval will have a 🗸 in the appropriate column.

#### **Special Populations**
